

NEW HALLS – New Buzz!!

The restructuring of Harrogate Nursery Fair halls is proving incredibly popular with exhibitors wishing to claim their stands again for the 2012 Fair! We are pleased to report an almost sold out show next year.

Harrogate International Centre has recently undergone major development adding a further 3,300 square metres of exhibition space and an expanded and improved main entrance. The hugely successful show last year, with visitor numbers up on previous years despite the economic climate, has no doubt also contributed to exhibitor confidence and companies such as Summer Infant, Clair De Lune, Tippitoes, Bibs n Stuff and Oxo Tot have all increased their stand sizes significantly. The majority of regular exhibitors will once again be in situ and the show is also delighted to welcome back companies which are returning after a few year’s absence such as Padgett Bros and Brother Max. Also, a number of new to Harrogate companies such as Joie and Vital which have both confirmed large stands.
